

Information Sharing Session January 16, 2019

The first information session was held on January 16. Dr. James McGowan was our clinician. The session lasted past 12:00 PM. Dr. McGowan encourages experiential learning, showing students right from the start to improvise according to a frame of reference given by the teacher. He introduced the Bloom's Taxonomy philosophy: students start by recalling basic facts, concepts, ideas, connecting and transferring them to producing new and original work. He also believes in the multiple intelligences philosophy introduced by H. Gardner. Singing and Solfège are also essential parts of developing musicianship. Coffee, cookies and more discussions completed our gathering. It was a very informative session.
